TERM 1 2019 - Roar Performing Arts Academy Classes

Learn to sing, act and dance and have fun performing on stage at our purpose-built small theatre at 102 Anzac Avenue, Redcliffe – next to the Redcliffe Hospital.

Monday:

- 4-5pm – BEGINNER Musical Theatre (song and dance) Class – suggested age 5-8yrs (\$120)
- 5-6pm – JUNIOR Dance – exploring basic dance skills for theatre performance (\$135)
- 6-7pm – Musical Theatre DANCE Eisteddfod Class (\$135)
- 6-7pm – JUNIOR Drama – exploring acting technique, preparation of monologues, telling a story (\$135)
- 7-8pm – SENIOR Drama Eisteddfod class - exploring acting technique, preparation of monologues and poems and practice in the audition process (\$135)

Wednesday:

- 4-5.30pm and 7-7.30pm – Private Vocal (\$250 per 10 lessons or \$30 per lesson)
- 4.30-5.30pm – TAP for Musical Theatre (\$135)
- 5.30-7pm – BROADWAY Senior (Musical Theatre) class – learning triple threat and performance skills through musical theatre repertoire (\$175)

Thursday:

- 4-5pm – Private Vocal (\$250 per 10 lessons or \$30 per lesson)
- 5-6pm – BROADWAY Junior (Musical Theatre) – learning triple threat and performance skills through musical theatre repertoire (\$150)
- 6-7pm – Private Vocal classes

Saturday:

- 9-10am – Beginners Drama – exploring acting technique and telling a story through games – suggested age 5-8yrs (\$120)
- 10-11am – JUNIOR Drama Troupe – suggested age 8-11yrs with focus on preparation of performance pieces for the SE QLD Drama Festivals starting in Term 2 (\$135)
- 11am-12.30pm – SENIOR Drama Troupe – 11yrs plus with focus on preparation of performance pieces for the SE QLD Drama Festivals starting in Term 2 (\$150)
- 12.30-2pm – ADVANCED Drama Troupe – by invitation focus on developing highly skilled drama pieces for public performance at THEATRE 102 and for entry in Drama Eisteddfods and Festivals (\$175)

At ROAR ACADEMY we believe that acting is a life skill that develops creativity, collaboration and communication. These are vital skills for today's classrooms and tomorrow's working adults. While we teach all the core triple threat skills – acting, singing and dancing – we put emphasis on acting as the single most important skill to develop to fully engage and communicate with an audience. We offer various drama classes, holiday workshops and ensemble programs for students from 5 years of age through to adult. Our courses provide children and young people of all levels of experience a chance to express themselves theatrically and discover the power of their own creative voice and imagination, all while having fun!

Terms of enrolment

Students MUST enrol in a DANCE class (any one) if they wish to be considered for JTC 2019 as we are looking for strong dance and great characterisation abilities.

If you are enrolled in the BROADWAY Class you will get a dance class at half price.

Students joining the SENIOR and ADVANCED Drama Troupes – NOTE this is a **full year commitment** as the Drama Festivals run from late June to early September and then we will look to run a series of performance nights at THEATRE 102 in Term 4.

During TERM 2 we will audition for places on the JTC 2019 TEAM – if you wish to be considered for JTC (Junior Theatre Celebration) this year then you should enroll in the BROADWAY class. If you are chosen to be part of the JTC 2019 Team then you will be automatically considered for our 2020 UK JTF Tour and to be put forward for JTC Workshop opportunities – previous workshops have been NEWSIES Jnr and SISTER ACT Jnr.

(However, enrolling in BROADWAY does not mean that you have to join the JTC team).

BROADWAY classes and HOLIDAY WORKSHOP classes are not subject to discount.

Our Holiday Workshops are quite separate to the regular ROAR Classes as they will involve classes during School Holidays culminating in x4 performances . However, we will be running classes prior to the holidays to make the workload during the holiday week more manageable. There are no fees for costumes for these workshops.
